About Our Clinician:

Jim is an accomplished international Grand Prix competitor who is widely renowned in his field. Jim has trained and ridden a number of Grand Prix horses, included among them Art Deco, Donatelli II, and Don

Principe. He received the Dressage Foundation Anne Barlow Ramsay Grant and took Rhett to study in Europe with Michael Klinke for 3 months. Most recently Jim has trained and shown the beautiful pie bald Fresian mare Adiah HP who wowed crowds and won several USDF national championships at Grand Prix. Jim is very versatile and even took up eventing for a while in his career and rode at the then Rolex event in Lexington Ky.

Clinic Cost - Rider:

VADA-CH Member Riders:

\$100 per horse and rider for one day (includes lunch)

\$200 per horse and rider for both days (includes lunch)

Non-VADA-CH members Riders:

\$160 per horse and rider for one day only (includes lunch)

\$320 per horse and rider for both days (Includes lunch)

Clinic Cost - Auditors:

VADA-CH Members – \$10 for the lunch per day

Non-VADA-CH Members - \$25 for one day or \$40 for the weekend (includes lunch).

Rider Sign Up:

To apply to ride, go to our website click on the clinic link to download the rider application and liability waiver and send them, a copy of your coggins, a copy of

your USEF vaccination report (blank of this is available on our website), and your check include stabling fees, **payable to VADA-CH**, to Sherri Booye 721 Lake Road, Troy, VA 22974. This clinic is first come first serve, with priority to VADA-CH members, but empty slots will be filled with non-VADA-CH members. Deadline for receipt of the application is July 24th.

Your clinic application must include all of the required documents and check to be considered registered for the clinic.

(Stabling is available - \$25/day includes shavings,) Please no cribs. You can leave your horse overnight. If you bring feed in baggies they will feed for you. Bring your own buckets and hay or they will provide hay if you prefer. Overnight turnout is also available. Stalls are dutch door and have bars in the upper half between horses.

From Charlottesville: Take Route 64 east to exit 136 Gordonsville, Orange onto Route 15 north. Stay on Route 15 for 2.2 miles to route 617E/E. Green Springs Road. Turn right and go 1.7 miles and turn Left into the driveway at the “Old Raptor Farm” sign. Follow gravel drive to white barn at the end. **Please be careful to adhere to the speed limits on Route 15, this is a speed trap area.**

From Richmond area: Take Route 64 to Exit 136, Route 15 north. Stay on Route 15 for 2.2 miles to Route 617E/E. Green Springs Road. Turn right and go 1.7 miles and turn Left into the driveway to the “Old Raptor Farm” sign. Follow the gravel drive to the white barn at the end. **Please be careful to adhere to the speed limits on Route 15, this is a speed trap area.**

From Orange and points north: Take Route 15 south from the circle in Gordonsville. Continue for 9 miles to Route 817/E. Green Springs Rd and turn Left. Go 1.7 miles and turn Left into the driveway at the “Old Raptor Farm” sign. Follow the gravel drive to the white barn at the end.
